Subject: November 25 2020 COVID-19 Pandemic Update

Unfortunately, there are now several active cases in our district. We have been planning for this and are going to be rolling out another pause in some of our activities.

As of today, there are at least 8 active cases and there are at least 2 others associated with the University who do not call North Bay home. We are going to be proactive and plan for the worst-case scenarios.

We are moving to a system reflective of the province's descriptions of restrictions. Using the province's guidance we are moving our organization to an "orange" zone. Below we will try to summarize what this move will mean to you and your family member. If you have any questions, please contact the manager for a more in depth explanation. This is not going to be an easy few days. As of today, we are putting a pause on the following:

Group Living/Family Home: Visits will be paused effective tomorrow November 26. Visits to family homes will also cease until we get a clearer picture of how our community is impacted. Outside Passport/respice workers will not be permitted to interact with persons living in our residences. Our visitor pod for essential visits is now available. You can make arrangements for this site through the manager.

We are asking for your patience while we navigate this next wave. We are very aware of the impact this information will have on you and your loved ones. We are hoping that by being very proactive it will halt any spread and we will be back to normal in the next week or two. We are implementing enhanced screening and PPE in the areas where there is a greater risk.
