**Subject: December 14, 2020 COVID-19 Pandemic Update**

We are one week closer to the goal of being a healthy community so that we may enjoy the holidays with our families.

We are looking at the Christmas week (Dec 21 –Dec 28) as being our re-open week. If all remains safe we will be opening our homes for visitors and allowing visits to your homes. This optimistic plan will of course depend on the status of the day. We will be monitoring this on a daily basis.

In addition to the restrictions that have been in place for the last few weeks we have increased the screening for our staff. We are asking families to consider the same risks we are asking of our staff. The new screening also asks everyone to take into consideration their contacts and the contacts of those in their homes. Although we are using our community status as our measuring stick, this does not guarantee that people are not in contact with people from the “hot zones”.

We are asking families to consider if they are in contact with or have people in their homes who have had contact with persons from the “hot zones” to follow the procedures of covid testing or 14 days of isolation. This additional screening is part of our enhanced protocols to keep everyone safe. We would also like to offer for those who would feel safer a supply of PPE that you can use while having your loved one home. Please contact the manager for some supplies.

Again I want to thank all of you for your support this past eight months. It feels like we have been at this for such a long time. It is our hope that 2021 is the beginning of our return to normal.
