**Subject: Continued Lockdown February 2021**

The continuation of the lockdown has been announced and we are not re-opening before February 16<sup>th</sup>. It is our expectation that we may continue in lockdown until February 23. Should the local Health unit district move to the provincial colour framework we expect to be in the grey zone. This will continue to keep us in a shut down. Our document for the Framework is available on our website.

We realize how disappointing this is for families. We will continue to try to facilitate individual circumstances however due to the presence of the variant of concern in our community and the swiftness of the spread experienced, we will be using an abundance of caution when making those determinations.

The following are just a reminder of our circumstances.

### Residential Services

We will continue to host essential visits at our visitor pod throughout the lockdown. Other visits are not permitted. The guidelines for visits to the pod will remain as previously established. Should there be some changes to circumstances we will post a notice as soon as we are made aware. Outdoor visits will not be permitted until there is a marked improvement in our numbers.

### Other Services

Our other services will be continuing the current service offerings where possible however there may need to be a stoppage if the spread continues.

I am sure everyone is tired of hearing this news, families are desperate to reconnect, our mental health and our stress levels are off the charts but you have my commitment and the commitment of Community Living North Bay employees that we are going to continue to do our best to keep your family member safe and assist both of you to make a bad situation just a little bit better.
