**Subject: Easter Plans**

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We remain in the Yellow Zone. Planning for the upcoming holiday weekend we have made the decision to continue to observe the “Additional Precautions” with the following adjustment.

- Scheduled, supervised non-essential outdoor visits with physical distancing are permitted. Physical contact is not permitted. Indoor visits will be conducted at the visitor pod. This restriction is in place to be able to monitor the impact of the holiday and the scheduled March Break will have on our cases.
- All visits must be scheduled ahead of time, please arrange with the program manager.
- All visitors must wear a medical mask and eye protection. These will be provided by the program.

Although we have moved to yellow we will continue to observe the additional precautions until at least April 19<sup>th</sup>. We know that the full impact of high risk periods is not felt until several days after the event. We want to ensure that we are not becoming complacent and putting your family member at risk.

Should there be a change to our area we will of course follow the more restrictive rules of the red or grey zones. It is our hope that this does not occur.

The good news is that the 2<sup>nd</sup> phase of vaccine delivery includes our people and we are very hopeful that this occurs in the next couple of weeks.
