Subject: COVID-19 Pandemic Yellow Zone

We have been moved to Yellow Zone effective March 22. This does not mean changes to the way we are operating as we are still under the Additional Precautions outlined by our Ministry.

The category of “Additional Precautions” means that visitors are welcome under the following conditions:

- Scheduled, supervised non-essential outdoor and indoor visits with physical distancing are permitted. Physical contact is not permitted. Indoor visits will be conducted within the designated visiting space at the program or at the visitor pod.
- All visits must be scheduled ahead of time, please arrange with the program manager.
- All visitors must wear a medical mask and eye protection. These will be provided by the program.

Although we have moved to yellow we will continue to observe the additional precautions until at least April 6th. The sudden increase in cases Friday and over the weekend is alarming and we will be monitoring our area before we take on any more risk.

Our non-essential programs will remain closed except for those already determined as extenuating circumstances. If you are unsure of your situation please reach out to the manager of that program.

Good News. We will be participating in two vaccination clinics this week. Phase one eligibility is for congregate care persons over the age of 65 and the staff working in those environments. We are advocating to have clinics for the others at the beginning of Phase two. Other persons supported by Community Living North Bay and those staff will be the next to receive the vaccine.
